- The S&P/TSX Composite increased 0.84% on the week led by a 3.98%. increase in the Materials sector.
- June saw the Canadian economy lose 1,400 jobs as the unemployment rate climbed to 6.4% for the month, up from 6.2% in May, the unemployment rate is now at its highest level since January 2022 when it was 6.5%.

United States

- The S&P/500 Composite decreased 0.66% on the week.
- According to the Labor Department the U.S. economy added 206,000 jobs in June. Despite
 these gains the unemployment rate unexpectedly climbed to 4.1%, tied for the highest level
 since October 2021
