- The S&P/TSX Composite increased 4.05% on the week led by a 11.63% increase in the materials sector.
- According to Statistics Canada real gross domestic product rose 2.6% on an annualized basis
 in the third quarter of 2025 marking a rebound from a contraction of 1.8% in real GDP for the
 second quarter as U.S. tariffs took hold on the Canadian economy.

United States

- The S&P/500 Composite increased 3.73% on the week.
- According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics the producer price index, a measure of what producers get for final demand goods and services, increased a seasonally adjusted 0.3% in September
